### JURY CONVICTS SEAN LANDIS IN 2024 SYLVANIA TOWNSHIP SHOOTING

**TOLEDO, Ohio** – Lucas County Prosecuting Attorney Julia R. Bates announced that on March 12, 2025, a Lucas County jury found Sean Landis guilty of multiple counts of attempted murder, aggravated burglary, and felonious assault — all with gun specifications — as well as tampering with evidence. The charges stem from the Sept. 9, 2024, shooting of two men in their Sylvania Township home in cases CR2024-02708 and CR2024-02478.

The two victims were asleep when Landis entered their home. He shot one victim three times and the second victim four times before fleeing. Authorities later apprehended Landis in Las Vegas, where they found blood from one of the victims on his pants. Investigators determined he spent weeks in Sylvania, Sylvania Township and Toledo before attempting to kill the two men.

“This case was about obsession, jealousy and calculated violence,” Lucas County Prosecuting Attorney Julia R. Bates said. “We are grateful for the jury’s service and the opportunity to deliver justice for the victims. This case was a team effort involving our office, the Sylvania Township Police Department and other agencies from Northwest Ohio to across the United States.”

Sentencing for Landis is set for April 2, 2025, at 1:30 p.m. in courtroom nine of the Lucas County Courthouse.
