PETTAWAY PLEADS GUILTY IN FATAL PARKING LOT SHOOTING

TOLEDO, Ohio – Lucas County Prosecuting Attorney Julia R. Bates announced that Marvin Pettaway, 19, pleaded guilty in case No. CR2025-01578 to murder with a three-year firearm specification in the death of Jasmine Queen, along with three counts of felonious assault related to three other victims.

On Nov. 2, 2025, the Toledo Police Department responded to the plaza at the corner of Hill Avenue and Reynolds Road in Toledo on a report of shots fired at approximately 3:30 a.m. outside the Weekend Restaurant and Lounge. Queen and her friends left the bar, and while walking to their car, multiple people fired shots in the parking lot. Queen was struck and killed as a result of this reckless action.

“We hope this brings a measure of peace to Jasmine’s family and friends,” Bates said. “We are grateful to the Toledo Police Department for its thorough investigation of this terrible situation. Jasmine was simply leaving with her friends and going to their car.”

Sentencing for Pettaway is set for June 9, 2026, in Courtroom 5 of the Lucas County Courthouse. He faces a minimum prison term of 18 years to life and a maximum sentence of 48 years to life. He will not be eligible for judicial release. The remaining counts will be dismissed at sentencing.

Marshaun Purley, 18, is scheduled for trial June 8, 2026, on related charges. Brooklyn Cobian, 20, also is scheduled for trial June 8, 2026, on a single charge of obstructing justice.

Assistant prosecutor Angela M. Zovac led the case for the Lucas County Prosecutor’s Office.
